# Staying On Schedule



- Not considering the impact of the renovation on the energy efficiency and environmental impact of the home
- Not paying attention to the quality of the workmanship and materials used
- Not having a clear plan for the disposal of debris and waste generated during the renovation
- Not having a plan for where you will live during the renovation if it is a whole-house renovation
- Not considering the potential impact of the renovation on the neighborhood and community

#### MAKE SURE YOUR RENOVATION COMPANY ACCOUNTS FOR THESE DETAILS

- Lighting fixtures and switches placement
- Electrical outlets and their location
- Ventilation and air circulation
- Room layout and flow
- Storage space and organization
- The placement and size of windows and skylights
- Soundproofing and acoustics

- Accessibility and safety features, such as handrails and slip-resistant flooring
- The quality of the paint and the finish
- The flow of the water and drainage in the bathroom and kitchen
- The color coordination and matching of materials
- Heating and cooling needs of the new space

#### Project Worksheet

Choosing the right remodeling company can be a daunting task. Use this worksheet to help you in the selection process: **Define your project:** Clearly outline the scope of work, including any specific details or requirements. **Research potential contractors:** List the companies that specialize in the type of remodeling you're interested in. Look for online reviews, check the company's website and portfolio, and ask for references. **Check for communication and customer service:** Ask how they will communicate important project info to you? How often will they provide updates? Will they provide photo updates to keep you informed? **Schedule consultations:** Schedule consultations with at least three different companies and ask for detailed proposals and estimates.
